He received a Doctor Artium degree on 20 Mar 1571 at University of Douai in Douai, France. Gaspar received a Baccalaurus Juris (law) degree after 1571 in Leuven, Vlaams-Brabant, Belgium. In 1577 he was appointed clerk of the Council and Audit Chamber and the Feudal Court of the Marquises of Bergen op Zoom. In 1584 he was appointed clerk to the House of Orange, following William of Orange's murder. In 1591 in The Hague (Den Haag), Den Haag Municipality, Zuid-Holland, Netherlands Gaspar was appointed a councillor in the Council of Brabant. He lived at 11, Lange

Vijverberg in The Hague (Den Haag), Den Haag Municipality, Zuid-Holland, Netherlands from 1597. He died on 11 Dec 1603 at the age of 51 in Den Haag, Zuid-Holland, Netherlands.<sup>9</sup> Gaspar was also known as Jasper van Kinschot. He was also known as Caspar van Kinschot. KINSCHOT (Mr. Jasper van) (1), of Casper, Gaspar v.K., geb. te Turnhout 15 Oct. 1552, overl. te 's Gravenhage 11 Dec. 1603, zoon van Zeger v.K. en Josine Roelofs.

Hij bezocht de hoogeschool te Keulen sedert 1567 en werd daar 5 Mei 1570 baccalaureus, vertrok in 1570 naar Douay en werd daar 20 Maart 1571 doctor. Nog in 1583 woonde hij te Bergen op Zoom, in 1585 te Delft (huis van Polanen) en sedert 1590 te 's Gravenhage (Korte Nobelstraat, in het huis van Bronckhorst, en in 1601 op den Kortten Vijverberg).

Hij huwde tweemaal. Eerst te Bergen op Zoom 28 Oct. 1578 met Josina Pijll, geb. op het kas-teel Wouw bij Roosendaal 25 Jan. 1562, overl. te 's Gravenhage 11 Dec. en begr. 20 Dec. 1601 op het hoogkoor in de Gr. Kerk, dochter van Nicolaas en van Cornelia Boulijn. Daarna te Vlissingen (ondertr. 19 Juli) 1603 met Marie de Chantraine dit Broucqsault, geb. te Brugge, overl. te Lillo 1 Aug. 1631. Zij was eerder wed. van Geleyn de Best, en dochter van Jacob, burgemeester van Brugge, en van Adriana de l'Ecluse.

[Kinschot, Mr.. Jasper (1)]

KINSCHOT (Mr Jasper) (1), of Casper, Gaspar UK, geb. Oct 15 at Turnhout. 1552, died. The Hague December 11 1603, son of Zeger v.K. Roelofs and Josine.

He attended high school in Cologne since 1567 and was baccalaureus May 5, 1570, left in 1570 to Douay and became Doctor March 20, 1571. Since 1574 in Brussels in order to learn the practice of Law, where he enjoyed Sept. 1575 to August 1577 informing his cousin Mr. Hendrick UK, the skills lawyer, mentioned above. Den 28. July 1577 was appointed clerk of the Court and Leenhof of Bergen op Zoom, later judge at the Court of Brabant,

and finally to counsel and treasurer-general of Prince Maurits. Even in 1583 he lived in Bergen op Zoom in 1585 in Delft (home of Polanen) and since 1590 in The Hague (Short Nobelstraat, van Bronckhorst in the house, and in 1601 at the Tun).

He married twice. First in Bergen op Zoom Oct 28. 1578 Pijll with Josina, b. the greenhouse near Roosendaal-mently Kite January 25 1562, died. The Hague December 11 and buried. December 20 1601 for the chancel in the Gr. Church, daughter of Nicholas and Cornelia Boulijn. Then in Flushing (July 19 ondertr.) 1603 by Marie de Chantraine this Broucqsault, geb. Bruges, died. Lillo to August 1 1631. She was previously wed. Geleyn of the Best, and daughter of Jacob, Mayor of Brugge, and Adriana de l'Ecluse.

This second marriage produced Grotius latijnsch a wedding poem.

Two sons from first marriage, Louis and Nicholas, follow.

**Gaspar van Kinschot**<sup>16-17</sup> was born on 12 Nov 1622 in Den Haag, Zuid-Holland, Netherlands.<sup>16</sup> In 1647 in Münster, Germany he had their portrait painted by the artist Gerard ter Borch, and was painted whilst van Kinschot was part of a Dutch peace delegation.<sup>16</sup> In 1647 he was appointed to be in the entourage of the Dutch embassy at the Peace of Münster. Gaspar died on 31 Dec 1649 at the age of 27 in Middelburg, Zeeland, Netherlands.<sup>16</sup> In 1650 he had their portrait recorded by etching. The etch was created by Wenceslaus Hollar, after the earlier portrait by Gerard ter Borch.<sup>17</sup> He was also known as Caspar van Kinschot. Gaspar was a Poet. KINSCHOT (Mr. Jasper van) (2) of Casper, Caspar v.K., geb. te 's Gravenhage 12 Nov. 1622, gedoopt op denzelfden dag in de Gr. K., overleden te Middelburg 31

Dec. 1649, begraven Gr. K. te 's Gravenhage, zoon van Mr. Louis (of Lodewijk), die volgt, en van Maria de Jonge.

Hij legde zich bijzonder toe op de latijnsche dichtkunst en studeerde in de rechtsgeleerdheid, waarschijnlijk eerst te Utrecht, maar sedert 21 April 1640 te Leiden. Daarna bereisde hij een groot deel van Duitschland, Zwitserland en Frankrijk en promoveerde vermoedelijk te Orleans in 1645.

In 1646 werd hij gekozen in het gevolg van het nederlandsche gezantschap, dat naar Munster werd afgevaardigd om over den vrede te onderhandelen. Waarschijnlijk ging hij als particulier secretaris van een der gevolmachtigden (Adr. Pauw?) mede.

Hier viel hem, wegens zijn hoffelijke en innemende manieren de eer te beurt om de echtgenoot van den franschen ambassadeur, de hertogin de Longueville, die te Munster met groote statie haar intocht deed, namens den nederlandschen ambassadeur te begroeten. Bij de vreemde gezanten was hij zeer geacht; hij maakte te Munster vele vrienden, waaronder den kardinaal Fabio Chigi (den lateren paus Alexander VI), en zou het op de staatkundige loopbaan waarschijnlijk ver hebben gebracht, indien hij niet op jeugdigen leeftijd was overleden.

In het begin van 1649 keerde van Kinschot naar 's Gravenhage terug, zette zijn studiën voort en bleef de fraaie letteren getrouw. Zijn dichterlijke aanleg werd door omgang met Nic. Heinsius en anderen sterk ontwikkeld: in zijn gedichten zag men een meer dan gewoon talent en men drong er op aan dat hij ze te zamen in druk zou geven. Zijn nederige aard verzette zich hiertegen en hij wenschte ze zelfs alle te verbranden. Maar ten laatste is dit door zijn vrienden verhinderd: zij werden zooveel mogelijk bijeengebracht, maar zagen pas in 1685 bij Arnoldus Leers te 's Gravenhage door de goede zorgen van Jacobus Gronovius het licht onder den titel: *Caspari Kinschotii Poëmata In Libris IV digesta, Quorum primus Sacra et Pia; secundus Elegias et Eclogas; tertius Res gestas; quartus Miscellanea continet*, met zijn fraai gegraveerd portret naar het beneden genoemde geschilderde portret door Gerard ter Borch.

Voor al die gedichten, welke betrekking hebben op het ontzet van Leiden, op den vrede van Munster en op de groote overwinning die M.Hz. Tromp in 1639 behaalde, werden als uitmuntend aangemerkt. Van v.K. kwam nog afzonderlijk uit: *Panegyris in laudem celeberrimae Roterodamensium urbis* (Rott. 1638).

Van Kinschot overleed aan de tering te Middelburg, oud 27 jaren, en was ongehuwd gebleven. Zijn portret geschilderd door Gerard ter Borch in de collectie jhr. Mr. A.R.P. van Kinschot te Rotterdam, een herhaling daarvan in dezelfde collectie; een miniatuur geschilderd door A. van Halen (uit het *Panpoeticon Batavum*) in het Rijksmuseum te Amsterdam; prenten door H. Bary (?) en W. Hollar.

KINSCHOT (Mr Jasper) (2) of Casper, Casper UK, geb. The Hague November 12 1622, baptized the same day in the Gr. K., deceased in Middelburg on December 31 1649, buried Gr. K. The Hague, son of Mr.. Louis (or Ludwig), which follows, and of Mary the Younger.

He concentrated specifically on the Latin poetry, and graduated in law, probably first in Utrecht, but since 21 April 1640 in Leiden. Then he traveled much of Germany, Switzerland and France and graduated probably at Orleans in 1645.

In 1646 he was elected due to the Netherland embassy, which was delegated to Munster to have peace negotiations. Probably he went as private secretary to one of the trustees (adr. Peacock?) Co.

Here he was, for his courteous and engaging ways to honor the wife of the French ambassador, the duchesse de Longueville, who with great pomp at Munster made her entrance, on behalf of the Netherlands ambassador to greet. At the foreign ministers, he was highly respected, he was at Munster many friends, including Cardinal Fabio Chigi (the later Pope Alexander VI), and it would be on the political career may well have been, if not at an early age was deceased.

In early 1649 came from Kinschot to The Hague again, continued his studies continued and remained faithful to the fine arts. His poetic creation was dealing with Nic. Heinsius and others strongly developed. In his poems saw a more than ordinary talent and they insisted that he would press them together in business. His humble nature, opposed this and he wished them all even burn. But at last it through his friends prevented: they were as much as possible together, but did not until 1685 when Arnold Leers The Hague by the care of James Gronovius light under the title: Caspari Kinschotii Poëmata in Libris IV digesta, Quorum primus Sacra et Pia, secundus et Elegias Eclogas; tertius Res Gestas, Quartus Miscellanea continet, beautifully engraved with his portrait down to the painted portrait mentioned by Gerard ter Borch.

Especially those poems, which relate to the relief of Leyden, on the peace of Munster and the great victory that M.Hz. Tromp received in 1639 were classified as excellent. Of v.K. still came out separately: Panegyris in laudem celeberrimae Roterodamensium urbis (Rott. 1638).

From Kinschot died of consumption at Middelburg, 27 years old, and had remained unmarried.

His portrait painted by Gerard ter Borch in the collection of Mr. jhr. A.R.P. Kinschot of Rotterdam, a repetition of the same collection, a miniature painted by A. Van Halen (from Panpoeticon Batavum) in the Rijksmuseum in Amsterdam; prints by H. Bary (?) And W. Hollar.

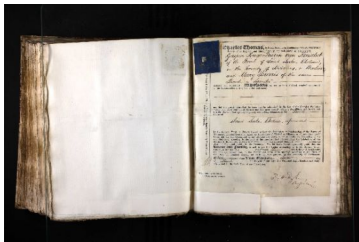
